As a WCO:

- Learning and developing skills relative to wildlife abatement and dispersal methods, including but not limited to falconry, vehicle (stalking), pyrotechnics, kites, distress calls, propane gas cannons, decoys, scarecrows, firearms;
- Identifying wildlife and collecting data on species and abatement;
- Handling, flying and husbandry of falconry birds;
- Maintaining company vehicles and other equipment in safe working order;
- Completing forms and daily activity reports, on a tablet.

As a Supervisor

- All the WCO tasks;
- In absence of the Project Manager, representative for Falcon at Vancouver Landfill for things such as daily airside operations;
- To ensure, on a daily basis, the smooth and efficient running of the wildlife management program;
- Apply and monitor Falcon safety and environmental policies;
- Assist the Site Manager, if needed, with:
 - Forms and daily activity reports, on the computer and tablet;
 - Schedule management to meet the criteria established in the contract.

Schedule

Depending on the season (high or low), we are in operation 7 days or 5 days a week. Candidates will be required to work shifts, holidays, mornings, afternoons and weekends, and must be willing to work on call. Shift lengths and the number of hours worked vary seasonally but are mainly 8.5 hours a day.
