Your responsibilities

As a Wildlife Control Officer (WCO), you will be using various tools and methods to mitigate the risks posed by wildlife hazards at Calgary International Airport. Your tasks will include, but may not be limited to, the following:

- Learning and developing skills relative to wildlife abatement and dispersal methods, including but not limited to the discharge of pyrotechnics and trapping activities (raptor trapping in particular). We could also train you for bird banding to support the Supervisor for this task;
- Falconry birds or other methods could be implemented in the future;
- Identifying wildlife, collecting data on species, and abatement interventions;
- Doing fieldwork and/or collect data for scientific studies;
- Maintaining company vehicles and other equipment in safe working order;
- Completing forms and daily activity reports, on computer and on tablet.
